For the reasons stated in this application, which of course state none, we grant exemption of personal appearance of the Commissioner today. The Learned Counsel appearing for the Corporation submits that the officers are present. Let Commissioner be present on the next date of hearing. In view of the exemption granted nothing survives in this application and the same is disposed of.</p> <p>We direct the Chief Secretary, Delhi to hold the meeting within two weeks from today along with Vice-</p>

Chairman of DDA, Commissioners of North Municipal Corporation and other respective Corporations, Member Secretary of DPCC, Secretary Environment and Managing Director of DSIDC. Upon deliberation, the following points shall be answered and reported to the Tribunal:

- 1) Whether Hazardous Waste can be deposited at Bhawna or at any other place in NCT, Delhi.
- 2) The cost that should be borne by each industry/unit generating Hazardous waste.
- 3) The plan for preparation of that site.
- 4) The list of the cement factories which will carry Hazardous waste from Delhi to their respective units at their own cost (as informed by the Learned Counsel appearing for the DPCC).

This minute shall be placed before the Tribunal positively before the next date of hearing.
